TYPOGRAPHY


Use bold fonts only for headings. Regular fonts are good for paragraphs.

COLOUR PALETTE

Here are the recommend colours. Note that it is not ideal to use, for example, the darkest green with the black as the contrast between the colours is small.

LOGOS

Logos of Athene and Ethana can be found from guild's website athene.fi/hallinto/materiaalit/

The guild emblem is a black half-helmet and an eye on a white background. The emblem may also appear without the white background.

As a general rule logos of partner companies should be used in black and white.







IMAGERY

When using photos remember to give credit to the photographer. Name of the photographer can usually be found from the description of the photo or from the photo album.

When using photos that only have a few people on it, ask permission from them.
